## NOTICE OF RACE

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 For protests where a Rule of Part 2 or Rule 30.1 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

### **2 ADVERTISING**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the R Class Skiff class that comply with the class rules.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Secretary, Naval Point Club Lyttelton, PO Box 19733, Woolston, Christchurch 8241 by 10.00 hours on Thursday 11 February 2010.
- 3.3 Late entries may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant and crew member's national authority.
- 3.5 Each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of an R Class Squadron.

### **4 FEES**

### **5 SCHEDULE**

- 5.1 Registration:  
Thursday 11th February 2010 from 0900 hrs to 1000 hrs at Naval Point Club Lyttelton.
- 5.2 Briefing  
Thursday 11th February 2010 from 0945 hrs at Naval Point Club Lyttelton.
- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 11.00 hrs
- 5.4 Racing schedule:  
The scheduled time of the warning signal for the Invitation Race is 1100 hrs on Thursday 11th February 2010.  
The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 1 of the championship is 1400 hrs on Thursday 11th February 2010.  
Up to three races, with two races back to back, are scheduled per day.  
A total of nine races (excluding the Invitation Race) are scheduled.  
No National Championship race shall start after 12.30 hours on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> February.
- A Sprint Series will run after National Championship racing on Sunday
- 5.5 On Sunday 14 February no warning signal will be made after 12.30 hours.

## **6 MEASUREMENTS**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate and in addition measurement checks may be made.

## **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

## **8 VENUE**

- 8.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.
- 8.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

## **9 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be Triangle / Windward Leeward and a harbour course.

## **10 SCORING**

- 10.1 The scoring system awards points according to the formula  $400 / (N+3)$  where N is the official finishing position of a boat.
- 10.2 Five races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3 No score will be excluded.

## **11 SUPPORT BOATS**

11.1 Support boats will be allowed.

11.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at registration.

## **12 LAUNCHING**

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Naval Point Club Lyttelton.

## **13 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
