NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- **1.3** Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the R Class Skiff class that comply with the class rules.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to admin@navalpoint.co.nz by 09:30 hrs on Thursday February 20 2020.
 - Payment can be made to NPCL Bank Account number 02 0864 0080191 00 with reference "R" and sail number.
- 3.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by entrant and crew member's national authority.
- **3.4** Proof of affiliated club membership to be presented at registration.

- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the Invitation Race and Race 1 of the championship is 11.00 hrs on Thursday 20th February 2020.
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 2 of the championship is 14.00 hrs on Thursday 20th February 2020.
- The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Friday, Saturday and Sunday is 11.00 hrs.
- **5.6** Up to three races, with a maximum of two races back to back, are scheduled per day.
- **5.7** A total of 9 races are scheduled.
- **5.8** It is the intention of the organisers to manage racing, including race start times, to maximise the number of races sailed in 12 to 18 knot wind strengths.
- **5.9** A separate Super-Cup Sprint Series will be run on Sunday 23rd February after National Championship racing is finished for the day.

6 MEASUREMENT

- **6.1** Each R Class boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- **6.2** A boat shall always comply with RRS 78.1 when racing.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

8 VFNUF

8.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.

8.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward; two laps.
Boats that have completed only one lap after the first boat has finished (have been lapped by the leading boat), will be finished at the end of that lap.
Points will be awarded in place sequence after the boats that complete the full course.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the R Class Skiff RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 The scoring system is as follows: The scoring system awards points according to the formula 400/ (N+3) where N is the official finishing position of a boat.
- **11.2** 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- **11.3** No Score will be excluded.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered and identified at registration. [DP]

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Naval Point Club Lyttelton. [DP]

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]




